# COVID-19: Ministry of Labour and Small Enterprise Development (MOLSED) urges the Public to use its Online Resources

Prime Minister, Dr. the Honourable, Keith Christopher Rowley M.P. at the Post Cabinet briefing held on Wednesday, 18<sup>th</sup> March 2020, stated that gatherings should be limited to ten (10) persons or less in an effort to limit the spread of the COVID-19 virus.

### On the Job Training Programme (OJTP)

Training Providers are advised that all On the Job Trainees (OJTs) who are assigned to their respective organisations must be included in any revised protocols or work flows which have been implemented in light of COVID-19. Trainees are asked to follow work guidelines set out by their respective employers at this time.

Additionally, Training Providers and Trainees are advised that timesheet submissions are suspended for the month of March 2020. However, all original timesheets <u>MUST</u> be secured for subsequent submission to the OJT Division.







Training Providers are to ensure that timesheets are stamped and signed for the period 1<sup>st</sup>-31<sup>st</sup> March 2020 and are available for submission upon request.

All <u>NEW</u> Applications to the On the Job Training Programme are suspended until further notice.
